

ROGUE VALLEY PIECEMAKERS QUILT SHOW

2018 SHOW REGISTRATION INFORMATION

You are invited to enter your quilts in the 2018 Quilt Show to be held May 11th and 12th at the Josephine County Fairgrounds in Grants Pass, OR. Please enter and display your quilts which are works of art.

ENTRIES RULES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Entry forms must be received by April 16, 2018, (second meeting in April.)
2. One form is required for each entry, to be accompanied by a photo of the quilt (contact us if you need help taking the photo.)
3. Each RVP member is limited to a maximum of 5 entries and non-member to 3 entries.
4. Your entry must never have been shown at a Rogue Valley Piecemakers Show.
5. RVP reserves the right to deny acceptance of any entry for just cause.
6. All quilt entries 48" or more must have a 4" sleeve sewn on the back at the top just under the binding.
7. Quilts over 86" wide will be gathered on the hanging rod.
8. Quilts of 86" in length will be hemmed with pins AFTER hung.
9. Each entry must have a label that includes the name of the entry and the name of the owner.
10. The label must be attached on the lower right hand corner of the back of the quilt.
11. Special handling of quilts will be provided when necessary (such as art quilts.) If you have question concerning special handling, please contact Barbara Hammel at 541-226-9444.
12. COMPLETED REGISTRATION FORMS MUST BE SIGNED, DATED AND RECEIVED BY MONDAY, APRIL 16, 2018, BY HARD COPY OR EMAIL

Check the block on the far left that best describes your quilt show entry:

1.	Hand Appliquéd Quilt – Large bed size (twin size 63 X 87” or larger) Must be 50% appliquéd.
2.	Hand Appliquéd Quilt – Small (less than 63” x 87”) must be 50% appliquéd.
3.	Machine Appliquéd Quilt - Large bed size (twin size or larger 63”x 87”) must be 50% appliquéd.
4.	Machine Appliquéd Quilt – Small quilt (less than 63” x 87”) must be 50% appliquéd.
5.	Pieced Quilt – Large bed size (twin size 63”x 87” or larger.)
6.	Pieced Quilt – Small (less than 63” x 87.)
7.	Modern Quilt - Characteristics include: use of bold colors and prints, high contrast and graphic areas of solid color, improvisational piecing, minimalism, expansive negative space, and alternate grid work.
8.	Wool or Felt Quilt or Wall Hanging - Embellished and/or embroidered.
9.	Group Quilts - More than two people involved in quilt top completion. Includes all techniques and all sizes. May be quilted by a person other than the makers of the top.
10.	Hand Embroidered Quilt - (Hand needle work) must be at least 50% embroidered.
11.	Machine Embroidered Quilt - Must be at least 50% embroidered.
12.	Charlie Harper Interpretative Art Quilt - Contact Barbara Hammel for details (541-226-9444.)
13.	Art/ Innovative Design - The quilt <u>must be an original design</u> , reflecting innovative construction and/or design techniques, themes or subject matters. No commercial patterns or copies of previous work can be utilized. Major portion of surface must be fabric. It may be of any technique or combination of techniques. The work must contain elements of quilting, i.e., surface, batting, backing, and hand or machine stitching/quilting. All embellishments must be securely attached. The quilt can be of

		any size and may be the work of one or more persons.
14	.	Art Quilts From a Commercial Design - May be of any technique or combination of techniques. All embellishments must be securely attached. The quilt can be of any size and may be the work of one or more persons.
15	.	Specialty Quilts - Specialty techniques would include, but not limited to whole cloth, yo-yos, cathedral window, stenciled, stained glass. The quilt may be the work of one or more persons, including quilting for hire, and of any size.
16	.	Miniature Quilts – A miniature quilt is a design that has been reduced in scale. All components: overall design, quilting design and stitches, binding, embroidery or other surface techniques or embellishments needs to be reduced in scale. When photographed with no scale for comparison the miniature shall look like a full size quilt, and only when a comparison is applied should the smallness be seen. <u>No side should exceed 24"</u> . The perimeter of a miniature quilt shall not be greater than 96".
17	.	Wearable Art/Accessories/Home Decorations - This category includes a wearable quilted item, a functional or decorative item (such as a table-topper, table runner, bag, box, etc.) The item must contain a surface design and backing. The surface design can be constructed using any/or multiple techniques: piecing, patchwork, appliqué, yo-yo, and embroidery, and may include either hand or machine quilting.
